



InnovaConcrete Abruzzo Workshop online: New materials for the conservation of cultural heritage in concrete

Chieti – Torricella Peligna (Italy) | 23rd – 24th Aprile 2021 - The 2nd Italian workshop of the InnovaConcrete Project, dedicated to 20th century architectural monuments and the problems of conservation and restoration, is scheduled for **23rd and 24th April 2021**. The virtual workshop entitled "**New materials for the conservation of cultural heritage in concrete**" is focuses not only on the technical conservation aspects of cementitious material, but also on raising public awareness of Cultural Heritage, through the involvement and narration of the experiences of the citizens, which with their stories focuses on the heritage conservation as a transmission of memory.

The webinar will be **organised by the Ministry of Culture through the Superintendency archaeological fine arts ad landscape for the provinces of Chieti and Pescara, in collaboration with ICOMOS, Municipality of Torricella Peligna, Department of Architecture of the University of Chieti-Pescara and professional associations (architects, engineers and journalists)** and it will be mainly addressed to professionals and researchers in the fields of architecture, engineering, restoration and conservation of cultural heritage and journalists interested in European policies and social aspects of the territory generated by the project itself as well as.

InnovaConcrete Abruzzo Workshop Online will be inaugurated on Friday 23rd April at 10:30 a.m. with the greetings of the Director of the Superintendency archaeological fine arts ad landscape for the provinces of Chieti and Pescara by **Rosaria Mencarelli**, and it will continue with the presentation of the project coordinator, **Maria Mosquera**, who will provide participants a general overview of the project and the objectives of the research. An interesting speech will be given by **Isella Vicini** on the new Horizon Europe Framework Programme.

During the workshop will be present leading figures from the world of architecture and conservation of cultural heritage to discuss and explore the concrete problems associated.

Claudio Varagnoli, Paul Gaudette and Stefania Landi will open the technical session, which will conclude with a presentation of the new materials study in the InnovaConcrete project.

On 24th April, will be dedicated to the Abruzzo Region. **Aldo Giorgio Pezzi** will open the session with a speech of places of memory and the conservation aspects of twentieth-century heritage. Then Monitoring systems, diagnostic methodologies and characterisation of concrete monuments will be illustrated, by a live presentation of the MiC-SABAP CH-PE which is a case studies of **Torricella Peligna**.

Finally, an interesting speech by **Stefania Melandri**, related to the aspects of dissemination in the area and awareness of the population, effect of the InnovaConcrete project.
